



MICHAEL J. YENNI BEAUTIFICATION AWARD

JB I is proud to announce that the Bunche Village Garden Club will be the recipient of the 2011 Michael J. Yenni Beautification Award. The award will be presented at the 20th Anniversary celebration of Parkway Promenade in Fall 2011. The award is given in recognition of continued outstanding maintenance of a public green space in Jefferson Parish. Garden Club members, Jacqueline Croon, Deadre Edwards, and Daisy Croon maintain the gardens with funds generated by Parkway Promenade as well as with private donations.

In 1994, Jefferson Beautification, Inc. obtained a Jefferson Parish Community Development Grant and provided matching funds to establish beautification plantings at the entrance to Bunche Village Subdivision on North Lester Street at Airline Drive. Plantings were installed on both sides of North Lester containing sprinkler systems and welcome signs.

The plantings were almost destroyed during Katrina, but were refurbished thanks to the efforts of the Garden Club members who obtained grants and donations for the project.
